Monday Ballet 5/6 is required to perform with 5/6's in recital. A minimum of 3 Ballet 5 classes is required to take Ballet. Ballet 6 students will be allowed to take less if necessary and recital and pointe options discussed. Levels 4x, 5 and 6 students not yet en pointe may enroll in Pre Pointe following technique classes. A student may not take the Pre Pt/Pt class without the ballet class prior.

Pre Pro is a special group of dedicated dancers who come together each Friday for strengthening, stretching and to work on skills needed to improve their technique. It is for levels 3, 3X, 4, 4x, 5, 6. There is no audition required for Pre Pro but dancers must take a minimum of two ballet classes per week to be a part of Pre Pro. Because of the amount of improvement Pre Pro students make during the year, the T/Th Ballet 3 class is reserved for those in Pre Pro. Pre Pro is not a regular technique class, but a focus on turns, petit allegro and grand allegro. This class also teaches proper etiquette in all professional situations and provides performance opportunities besides the annual recital such as local festivals, Christmas performance and opportunities to audition for LBT productions when children's roles are needed. A special uniform and studio warmup is required and light pink canvas ballet slippers. Those en pointe will also work en pointe.

ADVANCED PROGRAM SCHEDULE

ADVANCED STUDENTS MAY ALSO TAKE CLASSES FROM OUR REGULAR SCHEDULE.

This program was developed to meet the needs of the serious student who may possibly choose a career in the field of dance or pursue a college dance degree. Students **must be recommended or audition** for this program. Students who desire only 2 or 3 classes a week should take classes in our excellent open program. Students in any Advanced Class must abide by an additional set of policies. A parent and dancer are to schedule a meeting with the director if this will be your first year in any Advanced class (with the exception of Advanced Tap) to review these policies. **Adv Pointe students who wish to perform with the Adv. Ballet program must take a minimum of 4 Adv Ballet classes. The required classes are listed below. All Adv Ballet students, LBT, LBT2 are required to take a minimum of 3 weeks of our 5-week BC Summer Workshop. Students who take an Adv Level Modern or Jazz class are required to take a ballet class during the year and a minimum of 3 weeks of Summer Workshop to remain in that level in the Fall.** Email Mrs. Lannin to work out conflicts in your schedule, or if you would like to add additional classes. Advanced adults may enroll in Adv Level classes with permission of an instructor. **Please dress neatly if you attend Advanced Classes as students have a dress code.**

Advanced and Company Requirements:

1. Required days for Advanced BALLET are M/Tu/Th/Sat. Wed and Fri classes are optional but highly recommended.
2. Advanced Modern and Jazz students are required to take at least one ballet class.
3. **Attendance must be limited to 3 absences a semester in order to remain in an Advanced class and/or recital dance or one of our dance companies.**

Note: Keep in mind that in order to be successful in the Advanced Ballet Program, 5 to 6 days a week of training is the universal standard. It is also important to study other styles of dance in order to achieve the versatility necessary for a career in dance. Those who are more interested in jazz, modern or other dance forms should realize that training in classical ballet is vital to your success. All dancers are encouraged to stretch daily and take some type of Conditioning to build strength and avoid injury.

LBT and LBT 2 minimum requirements:

Four ballet classes each week and modern and Jazz. Tap is optional but highly recommended for musicality and coordination.

IDC requirements: Jr and Int are required to take ballet, jazz, tap with modern and musical theater highly recommended. Senior members are required to take ballet, jazz, tap, modern.

TUITION

Tuition is charged per student. A full month's tuition is charged for all months, including those with 5 weeks, holidays and missed classes. Every student will pay a **\$50 registration fee** each Fall or upon registration. **All tuition and fees are non-refundable and no credits given.** Fall and Spring tuition amounts below DO REFLECT a 5% discount for paying in advance. By the class rate is \$20. Professional rate is \$15 and must be approved by the school director. No professional rate can be given for Master classes or Mr. Jordan's tap classes. Please see our website regarding family discount, holidays, recital fees and dress codes. Classes with less than 7 students will be canceled and tuition refunded. While rare, faculty is subject to change.

LBT and LBT 2 pay an Annual Fee to LBT.

RECITAL FEES AND COSTUME PAYMENTS:

Students enrolled by Jan. 5th may participate in an exciting annual recital at the end of the year. A recital agreement will be issued/emailed and must be returned by Nov 1. There is a RECITAL FEE OF \$90. (Family Max is 2 recital fees) and is due March 1st. A costume is purchased for each dance form they study. Costume payments are based on age, and we begin posting costumes in October. If you decide you cannot participate, please notify us in writing by Nov 1st and we will not order costumes for your dancer and refund any costume payments made.

COSTUME FEES: One costume payment due with October Tuition. Those with more than one costume should pay for one or two costumes each month until all are paid for. However, all costume balances are due in January.

Ages 5 to 11 - \$75 per dance form
Ages 12 and up and Adv. \$85 per dance form
